Gremlins Carnival Club was formed by ex-members of the Royal air Force in 1948.

Founder members included John 'Dinger' Bell Snr, Chris Allen, Mick Merrett, Ted Lockyer, Gordon Blewit and Stan Evis.
The club was first known as the RAFA Carnival Club, changing its name to Gremlins in 1950.



Our first entry was "The Pages of Rhythm" in 1949, which won the carnival concerts. Not bad for the first attempt!



Success on the road took a little longer to achieve.

The club took a year off in 1958, but won its first carnival at

North Petherton in 1960 with "Moby Dick".



Winning Bridgwater took the club nearly 25 years to do. However, in 1971 "Carnival Tijuana Style" brought home 1st prize for the first time.



Despite mixed results through the 1970's, the club won the feature county cup three times in '72, '74 and '75, going on to win the overall county cup for the first time in 1978 with "Galactic Gradians".



With "Galactic Guardians" pushing the boundaries of carnival, the club continued to be as innovative as possible.

Our 1983 entry "Circus Comes to Town" was the first to feature a decorated tractor and generator as well as the main cart.



The 1990's saw the club win Bridgwater 6 times consecutively, beginning with "Starfighters" in 1991.



The most successful road entry produced by the club was "Ghost Ship (Deliver Us)" in 2006. An amazing 61 trophies were collected.



Success on the stage began to make a comeback in the 2000's.

To date our biggest trophy haul came from

"Midnight Masquerade" in 2007, winning 5 awards.



Since the clubs 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, success has continued in abundance. Our 2010 entry "Go West / Wild Bill's Runaway Train" became the first entry to win stage, road, and overall county cups.



Overall wins on the stage, road, and county were achieved again in 2012 with "Revolution".



Innovation within the club continued in 2015, with "Lights, Camera, Action" becoming the first cart ever to be fully lit by LED lamps.

Another overall county champion.

The club is still breaking records to this day. Our 2018 stage entry "Wasteland 3000" (pictured overleaf) was crowned the winner and kept the club in the top two on stage for an incredible ten years.

Since the Club first won the Bridgwater Carnival back in 1971, Gremlins have taken part in all 336 county carnivals, winning 146 times (43.5%) and being in the top 3 positions on 257 occasions (76.5%)
